Simultaneity of beauty and destruction.

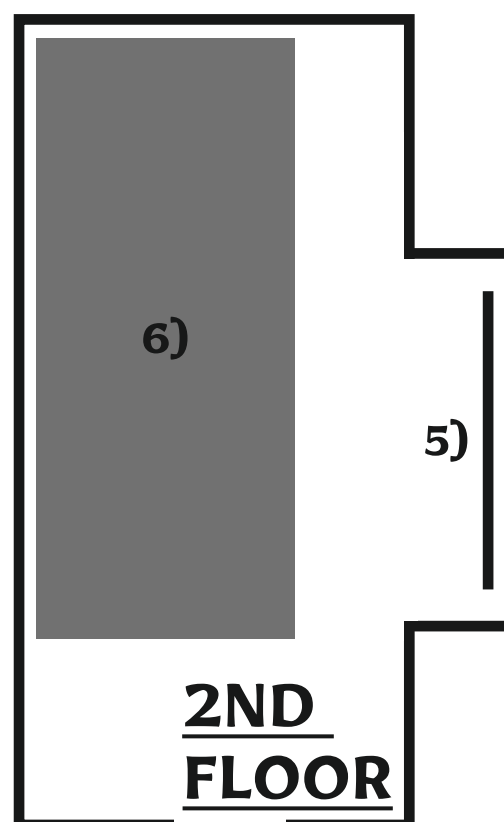
4) - PHOTO SERIES -

Staircase

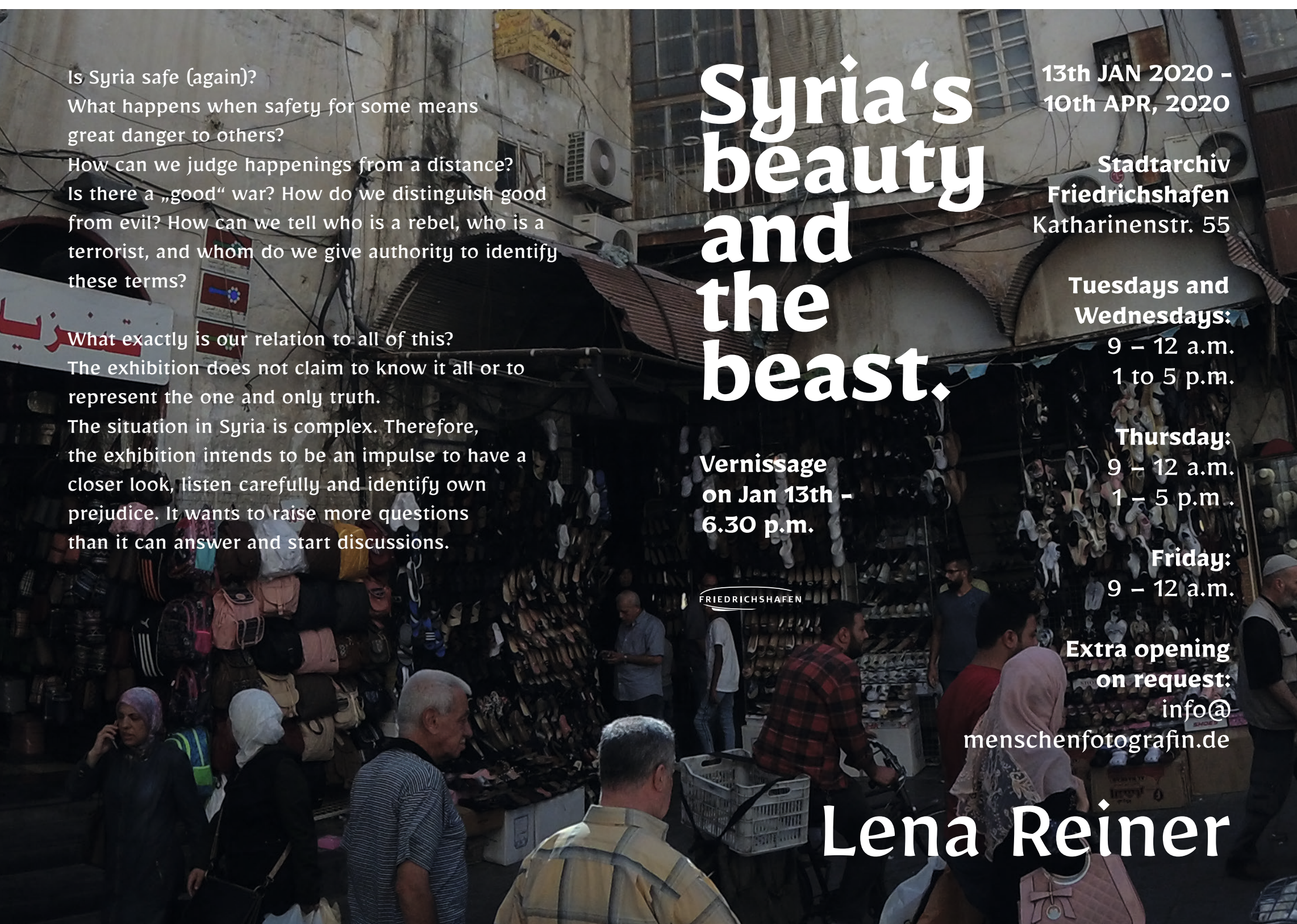


2nd floor: Extra room
